

- Engineering Controls
- Slips, trips and falls
- Bloodborne pathogens
- Ergonomics
- Training

ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROLS

- Is Mid-level and line supervisors ensuring adherence for department policies?
- Is just in time education and documentation being issued to staff members?
- How often are staff observations be conducted?

- Is dusk reduction procedures be followed in construction zones?
- Are vaccination schedules consistently followed?

BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS

- Infection control policies
- Annual Hep B and Flu vaccines
- Hand washing to prevent disease transmitting

ERGONOMICS

- Lifting techniques
- Staff chairs and workstations

TRAINING

- Annual
- Refresher
- As needed
- Just in-time

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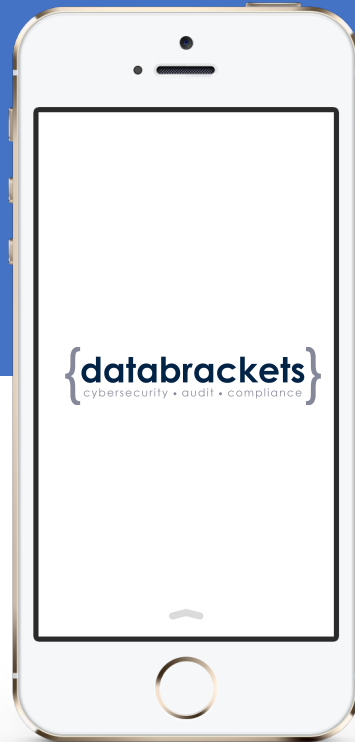
